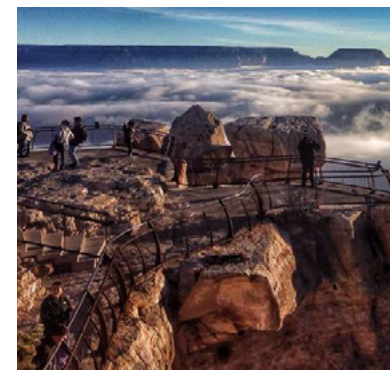

Facilities

Laundry: Cards cost \$1 and can be purchased in the library. Money can be added at the library
