**Breakfast:** 07:30 - 08:30 - Continental breakfast and with cooked breakfast once a week.


**Lunch:** 12:00 - 13:30 - 2 course lunch including a vegetarian option.

### Facilities

**Sports:** There are plenty of spaces on campus where students can play sports. There are extensive fields where groups can play football, team games and rounders. A sports arena and 3G pitches will also be available during on-site activities.

**Other:** On-site café and plenty of spaces in the main building where



groups can meet. There is access to the common rooms based in the accommodation during the evening and break times.

### Computer Access

Computers are available on City Campus in the main building room. Wi-Fi access will be provided on arrival to the campus and is available at the accommodation and classroom blocks.

### Laundry

Laundry facilities are available on the City Campus. Use of facilities is through a phone application or via a laundry card available at the reception desk, on which you can preload money online. One large and one small towel will be provided on arrival at residence.

### Security

There is a 24-hour security team that work to keep the campus secure. There are no safes in the bedrooms, however, the Centre Manager can store money/passports in the centre safe. One card and key is available per room.
