BEO FORUM

It is your responsibility to log in and check the Forum regularly to ensure you are up to date with all the information pertaining to the competition.

BEO PORTAL

You will receive your personalised log in details at a later stage this is to protect the personal information of your students. You will use this site to submit:

- your students' data (name, DOB, passport-size digital photo), which is essential for the competition IDs
- your song lyrics for the BEO Song Contest
- your drama script (optional submission!)

The submission date for all of these is 1st March 2023 but you will have your log in before the end of 2022 to ensure you have enough time to submit little by little and at your convenience.
