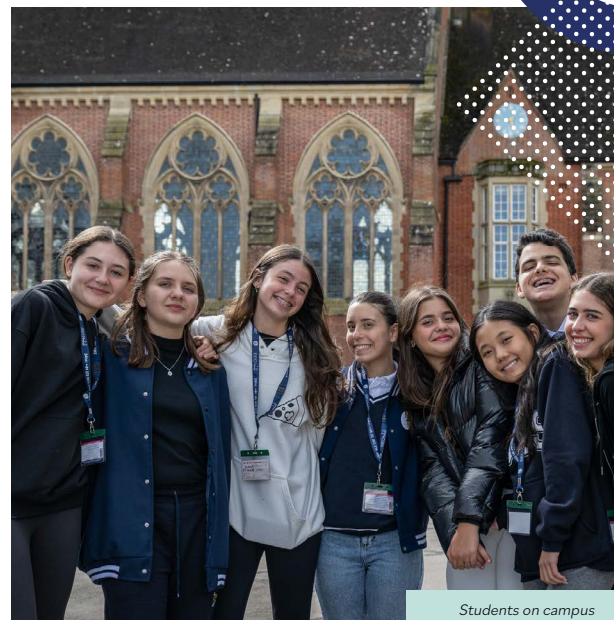

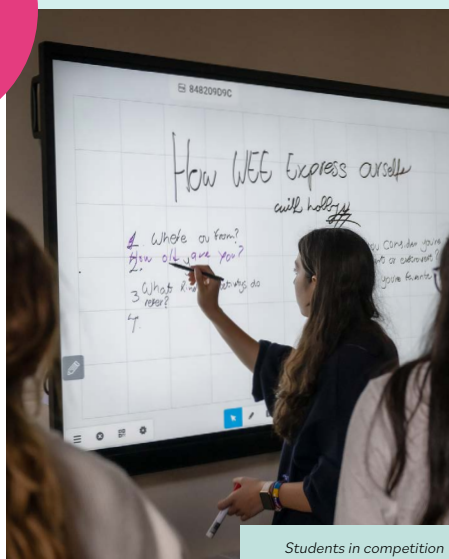

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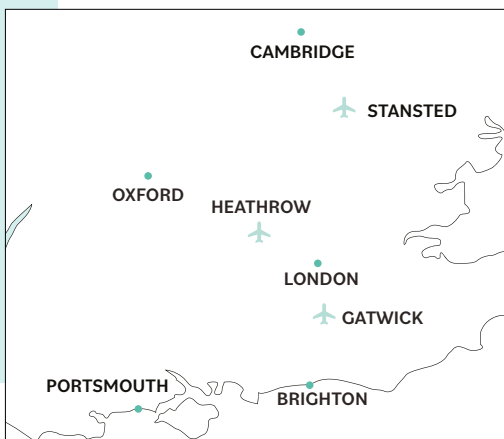

## How the Competition Works

Groups who wish to join the World English Experience can register their interest and receive a set of guidelines. The guidelines detail each competition, along with tips for preparing students before arrival.

- Each group enters the competitions as a collective team.
- Every competition can be won individually – scores are kept throughout the programme and the top two teams will compete in a final play off to determine the overall winner.
- There are other prizes available, including audience awards, individual achievements and the popular fair play award, voted for by the group leaders and awarded to the school felt to best represent the values of the Spring Standard programme.
