Transport

Airports:

Heathrow: 40min
 Gatwick: 1hr 20 min
 Stansted: 2hrs
 Groups/individuals are met at the airport by an Activity Leader. Groups will travel to the designated meeting point and individuals will travel straight to their homestay.

Nearest Town: Theale, 10 minutes via taxi.

Coach: 1hr 20min to central London.

Rail: 25 minutes to central London from Reading station.

Security

Bradfield College is the only inhabitant of the village. All buildings are owned by the school making it a safe place to study. There is a 24-hour security presence and staff are on call 24-hours a day. All boarding houses have entry code doors and bedrooms have lockable cabinets.
