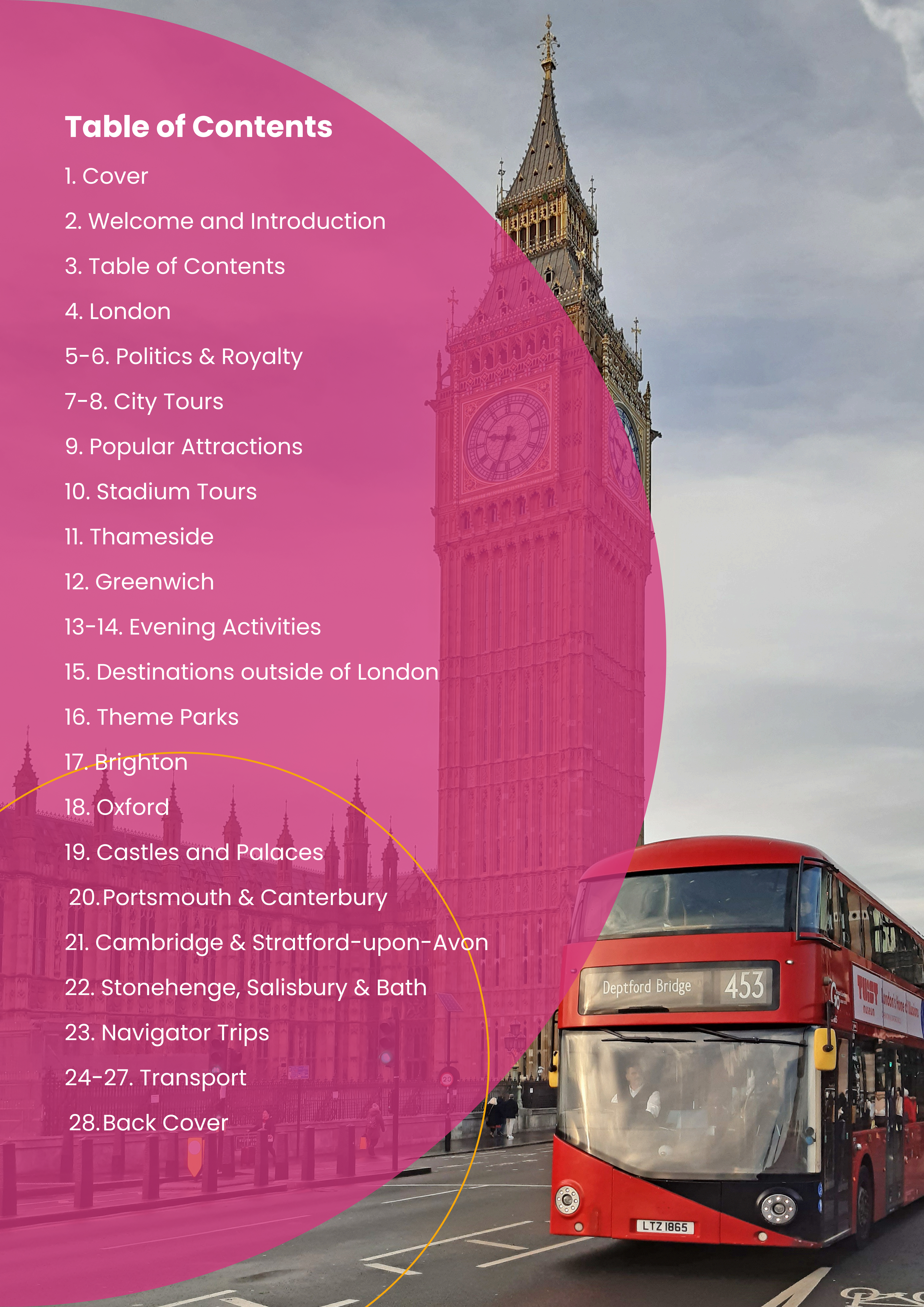

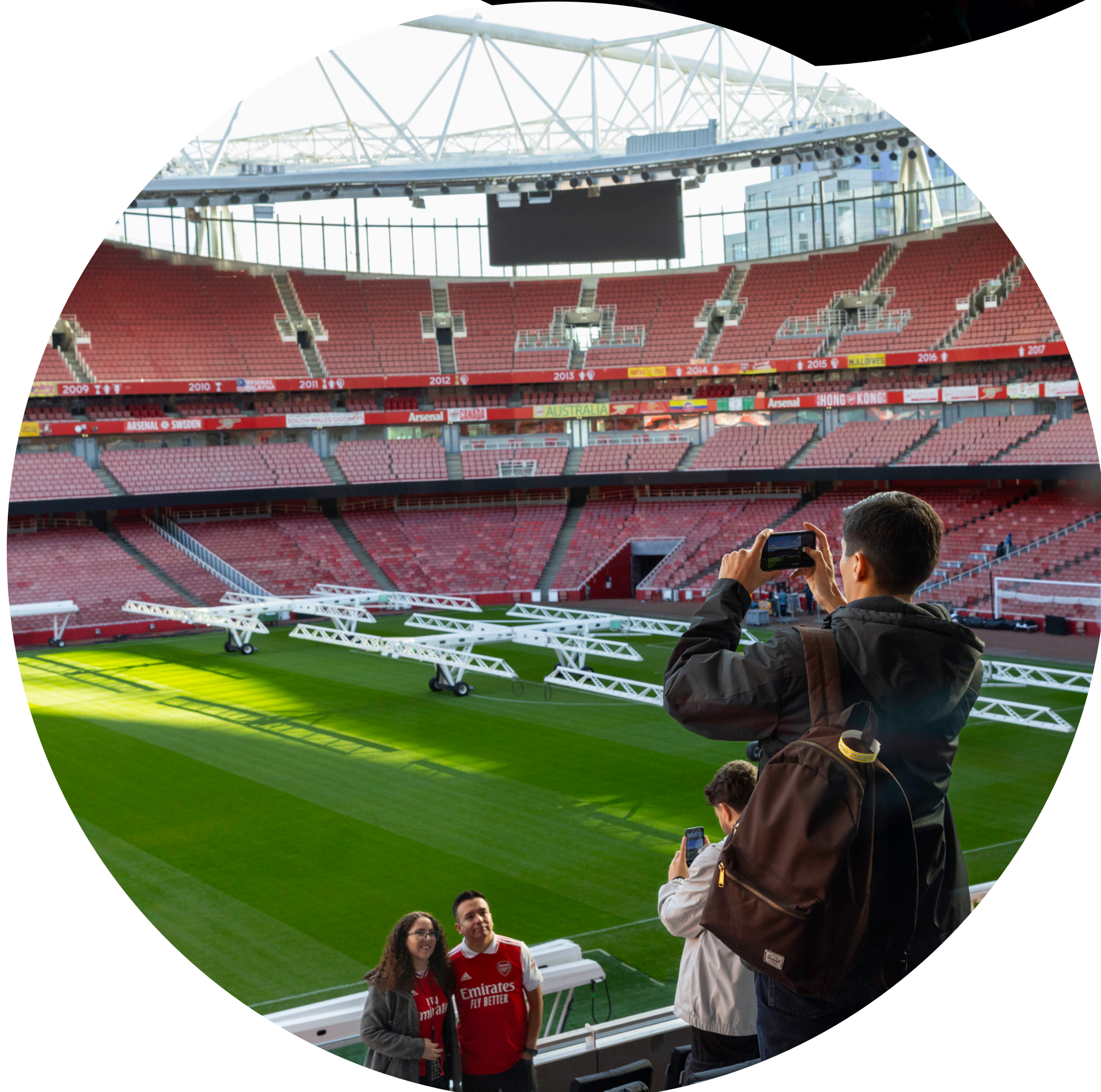

# Canterbury

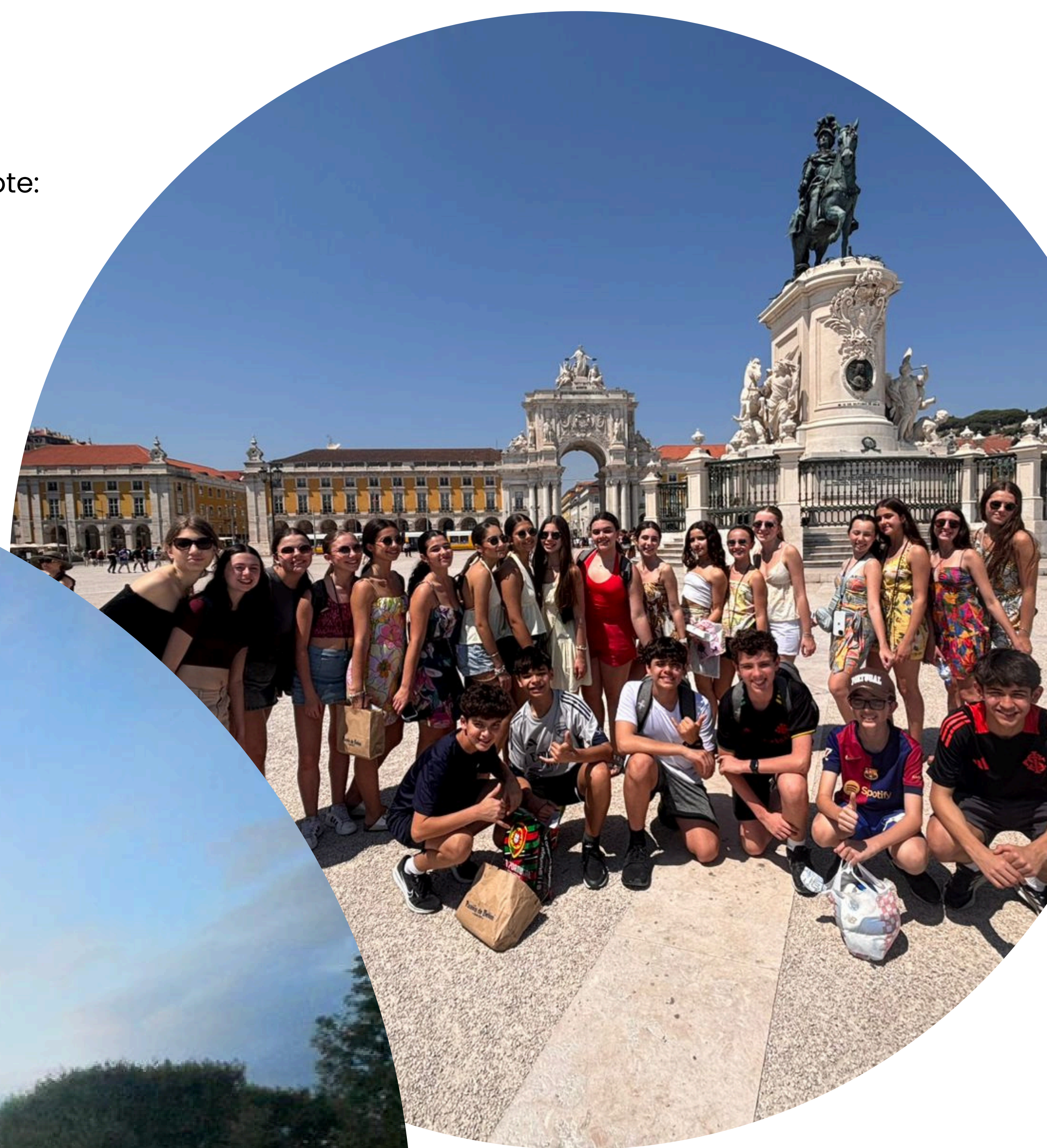
