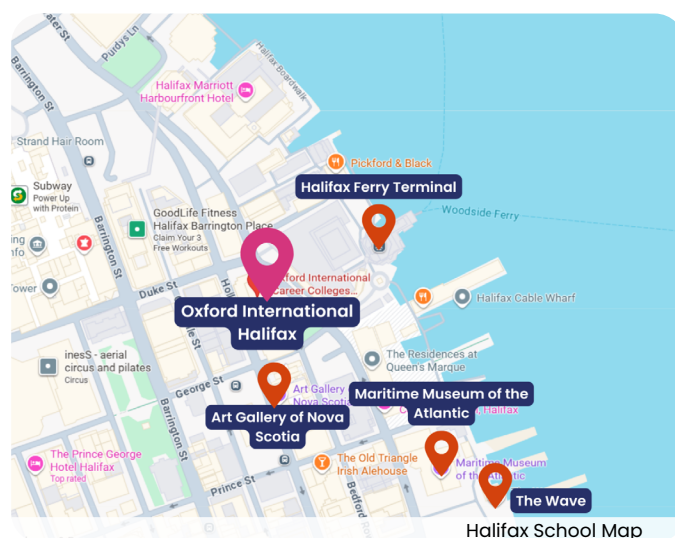

What's Included?



Accommodation

Twin-room homestay with Wi-Fi and weekly laundry for stays over one week.



Course

15 hours of English lessons per week, taught at OI Halifax.



Certificate

Graduation certificate recognizing student's progress and achievements.



Meals

Breakfast and dinner with host families. Packed lunch provided.



Activities & Excursions

Half-day excursions and one full-day excursion per week.



Materials

Learning materials included.



Airport Transfers

Halifax Stanfield International Airport: 40 min. Airport meet & greet included.



Local Transportation

Provided to and from accommodation and for excursions.



Halifax English School

Homestay: Provides the unique experience living with a local family.

Meals: The first meal is dinner on arrival and the last meal is breakfast on departure.

Accommodation: All students need to bring their own towels and toiletries.

Transportation: 3-minute walk from Oxford International to Halifax Waterfront. Homestay to school is average 45 minutes by public transport.

Activities & Excursions

A standard two-week program includes 2 full-day and 10 half-day excursions.
