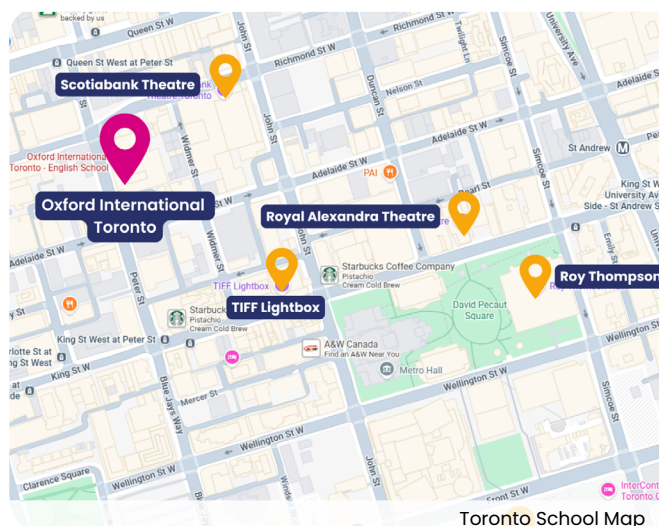

Accommodation

Twin-room homestay with Wi-Fi and weekly laundry for stays over one week.



Meals

Breakfast and dinner with host families. Packed lunch provided.



Airport Transfers

Toronto Pearson (YYZ): 40 min. Airport meet & greet included.



Course

15 hours of English lessons per week, taught at OI Toronto.



Activities & Excursions

Half-day excursions and one full-day excursion per week.



Local Transportation

Provided to and from accommodation and for excursions.

Homestay: Provides the unique experience living with a local family.

Meals: The first meal is dinner on arrival and the last meal is breakfast on departure.

Accommodation: All students need to bring their own towels and toiletries.

Transportation: 2-minute walk from Oxford International Toronto to Queen St West tram stop. Homestay to school is average 60 minutes by public transport.
